Beach Park Rules

1. Resident members of Ulmstead Club and the immediate families of such members who reside with the member may use the park. Guests of a member are permitted when accompanied by that member or one of the member's immediate family.

2. The Beach Park, and all Ulmstead amenities, are for resident's personal use only. Ulmstead residents are **not** permitted to be paid for services on the premises.

3. Groups of more than 20 people must reserve a date and time for their events at the beach in advance. This helps avoid the problem of one group arriving at the beach and finding that another large group has already arrived and taken most of the tables. Reservation rules/guidelines are specified in a separate link on the website.

4. All tables and grills must be left clean. Trash cans should be emptied into the dumpster and bags should be replaced. Please do not dispose of dog waste in the beach park trash cans. We don't have a clean-up committee so we depend on you.

5. If your party has music, remember that there are families with young children living nearby. Please keep the volume reasonable.

6. There is no diving allowed from the bulkhead area, the rocks or the steps leading down to the sandy beach. The water is extremely shallow.

7. All young children must be supervised and stay within the confines of the beach park.

8. The gates to the park are locked after 9:00 p.m.

Beach Park Reservation Rules

**Reservations are taken merely as a courtesy to the community in order to help members plan their events with the knowledge of how crowded the beach may be on any given day. UCI members are always welcome at any time during beach hours regardless of private events or reservations. **

1. Ulmstead Beach may only be reserved by any UCI member in good standing.

2. The reserving UCI member must be in attendance during his/her event at the beach. Parents must chaperone children's and teens' parties and are responsible for any damage which occurs. Underage drinking is prohibited. Bring your own trash bags and dispose of them in the dumpster.

3. Group events are limited to 75 people. Parking is limited and it must be a primary consideration for large parties, especially if a majority of attendees are not UCI residents. Please be careful not to block resident driveways if you park on the street. Consideration of a

parking plan is recommended for any event over 50 people. This also allows for access to the Beach Park while an event is in progress. Upon request, 'No Parking' signs are available for use.

4. Reservations are briefly reviewed and may require follow up if there are concerns regarding parking, logistics, or access. In addition, if 3rd party vendors are organizing/participating in the event, they are required to produce certificates of insurance and sign an indemnification agreement(provided by UCI).

5. Plan to wrap up your event by 9:00 p.m. The gates to the park are locked after 9:00 p.m.
