And while we're getting "dirty" let's talk DUMPSTERS! The dumpsters are for dumping of garbage generated by the users of the amenities near which they are located. They are NOT for disposing of large household items or construction debris. Several times this summer we have had entire doors, lumber, and other large items clog the dumpsters. Your UCI volunteers are getting tired of having to pull large items out of dumpsters and dispose of them properly to avoid dumpster replacement fees. PLEASE be considerate and don't put anything in a dumpster that wouldn't fit in a large garbage bag.

## NAUTICAL

With nearly 100 boats occupying slips, over 150 kayaks, canoes, paddleboards and dinghies stored on racks at our 3 marinas and a busy boat ramp, it is clear that boating is a popular Ulmstead activity. This season again saw an increasing number of Ulmstead residents enjoying our nautical facilities.

Despite the fact that fall means cooler temperatures and shorter days it also brings some of the best cruising, fishing and crabbing the bay has to offer. Fall can also bring tropical storms to the Chesapeake and now is the time to prepare for such weather. Tropical systems can impact our area for hours if not days and can bring heavy rains, strong winds and very high tides.

To accommodate these tides mooring lines should be able to be adjusted from the pier. All lines should be properly sized for the boat and cleats. They should be inspected for wear and replaced when necessary. Anywhere the line contacts the boat, motors or pier should be protected with chafing gear to prevent wear and abrasion. Additional lines should be in place or readily available to add if needed. Maintain fully charged batteries and ensure bilge pumps are operating properly. High tides may require power to be shut off. Keep piers and fingers clear of all lines, hoses and power cords. If severe weather is forecast, trailer boats should be pulled from the water. Boats remaining in the water during severe weather need to be checked often.

This year saw a number of new boats and new boaters at Ulmstead's docks. If you are new or inexperienced, ask for advice from your fellow boaters. All are more than willing to help.

#### UCI Barn Feasibility Study Summer Survey

Hello UCI Membership,

The Barn Committee is conducting a survey of the membership about the materials presented to the community during the first half of the year. The link to the survey is at the end of this message. We ask that you please take the time to complete the survey, as your feedback is invaluable to the study and to help the neighborhood make informed decisions to determine our appropriate next steps. The survey will be ongoing until <u>September 10, 2022.</u>

If you haven't participated in any of the townhall meetings or overview sessions we have done over the last year and a half, or if you would like a refresher on the material that was presented, I would like to direct you to the UCI Website members section (www.ulmstead.org/login). Once logged in there, you can click on the section labeled "Barn" and then click on the "Ulmstead Barn Study Presentation" to review what we presented.

After the survey period concludes, we will be collecting the data from this survey to get a better understanding of the neighborhood's perspective on the information presented. Based on the neighborhood's feedback, we will then move into the planning phase to determine what it is required to turn this into a project we can execute. The committee will make any changes based on the feedback we get from the survey and work with an architect to get us construction plans. From there, we will have contractors bid the work to give us actual costs and would take that information and put together a budget plan for the community to consider.

How we decide to pay for this as a community is obviously something that is going to be of great interest to the community so we will be taking great care and effort to look at a number of different financial options and present our findings separate to any other budget discussion or meeting. Ideally, we would like to do this before the annual budget meeting in November but that will all depend on survey results and the ability of the architects and contractors to get us the information we need.

We do have a group of folks lined up to help with the budgeting aspect of this, but the committee is also looking to source some community resources around landscape design architecture and construction project management. If anyone is interested or know someone that has some experience in those areas and would like to help the committee and the community, we would appreciate the help!
