TENNIS

Spring is just around the corner, and we are finally going to get our courts refurbished!

While we were disappointed that the renovations did not occur in 2022, the delay gave us chance to spend more time on the renovation plans. In preparation for the spring renovation, the pine trees have come down along Lynch Dr (that lined the courts). We're excited that we are getting a restored court surface, new surface paint and lines along with new net posts and nets! In addition to this, we are getting two new permanent pickleball courts with official court markings and pickleball nets!! There is money in the approved budget for shade awnings and social seating as well. We have signed the contract, and are looking forward starting the work, possibly as early as April.

If you are interested in membership – new and renewing, the 2023 court dues are \$220. This gets you full access to the courts, and usage of Court Reserve, our online court reservation system. If you are a renewing member and need a new key, the cost of a replacement key is \$100. Dues are due by May 1st, there is a \$25 late fee for dues paid after May 1st. Checks can be made payable to UCI and placed in the mailbox at 658 White Swan Drive.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- The courts are **only** for tennis and pickleball members that have keys.
- Please **do not** bring your pets, scooters, bikes, roller skates/blades, skateboards, soccer balls, etc. onto the courts.
- Please **only** enter the courts through the main gate using your key.
- From a safety standpoint, **do not** climb the fence to enter the courts. **Parents (members and non-members), please pass this information along to your children.**
- Netted fencing has been added to protect court users from errant lacrosse balls.
