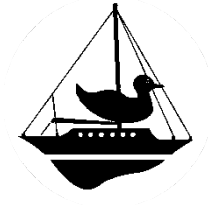

## NAUTICAL

As summer winds down and fall approaches, it is prudent to spend a little extra time preparing for the tropical systems and nor'easters that we usually experience on the bay. These storms can bring heavy rain, strong winds, and very high tides. Extra precautions should be taken to ensure that your boat is securely moored in your slip. Remember that you are responsible for all damages to UCI docks and other vessels caused by your boat. These precautions should include properly sized line in good condition, securely fastening these lines to the boat and pier, and chaffing gear to protect these lines. Extra lines should be ready, batteries fully charged, and bilge pumps should be in good working order.



To avoid tripping hazards, it is important to keep all dock lines, hoses and power cords neatly stored on the dock. No lines, cords, or hoses should ever cross or be left on the shared finger piers. And check your boat frequently. Notify your neighboring boat owners of any issues that you see, and do not be afraid to ask for help or advice. We have all been novice boaters at one time.

Fall also brings some of the best boating of the year. Temperatures and humidity

abate, fewer boats on the river, less crowds at area restaurants, and some of the best fishing and crabbing of the year. With proper precautions boating can be safe and fun for months to come.
