THE BARN

Thank you to everyone who attended our Annual Meeting! Your presence and participation make our community strong, and we appreciate the time you took to engage with the updates and discussions. For those who were unable to join us, here is a recap of the latest on the Barn Rebuild project.

We want to remind everyone that the challenge is not just rebuilding the barn itself, but navigating the complexities of the site it sits on. In addition to close neighbor proximity, the area presents significant complications, particularly as a Critical Area containing wetlands, streams, steep slopes, and underground infrastructure. All of this comes with limitations and constraints that result in numerous iterations of work that would not exist in other areas of the County.

We are fortunate to have an amazing team of experts, including knowledgeable residents with deep experience in architecture, engineering, design, and construction, as well as multiple firms we have contracted, guiding us through every phase from design development to permitting to construction.

We moved the building slightly to the east to meet county setback requirements and give our neighbors more distance from their property line to the building, and we had already reduced the footprint to account for impervious give backs. After making these adjustments and hiring our land use attorney this summer, UCI has submitted the Modification Request to the county, and notification letters have been sent to the neighbors. The county initially requested 45 days to respond; however, as of the date of this printing, it has been approximately 75 days. While we await their response, we have briefed Becker Morgan as our new architects and onboarded a new Project Manager from Atwell (Civil Engineering). We also know we will likely need to reshape the rear of the building to account for a new "steep slope extended buffer." As we've said repeatedly, this is an iterative process.

We also acknowledge this has become a very long process, often made to feel even longer due to budgetary cycles, the need for community input through surveys, meetings, and walk-throughs, in addition to those complexities imposed by the County and the site itself. These factors add nuance and

time, which can understandably be frustrating. However, we are confident that we have the right partners and people in place to bring this project to completion.

As I mentioned in the meeting, we are always open to suggestions, feedback, and questions. We recognize the significance of creating a gathering space that will serve our community for generations to come, and we are committed to achieving this in the most fiscally responsible way possible. Thank you again for your continued support and enthusiasm. Together, we are building something special!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Registration: Registration for the swim team will likely begin in April at ulmsteadswim.swimtopia.com. We will share the date online in the next Weathervane.
- Meets. There will be 5 swim meets on Saturday mornings (home vs. away to be announced later): June 14, June 21, June 28, July 12, July 19.
 - Kids must swim in 2 of the 5 meets to qualify for a medal meet. All kids who swim in at least 2 meets will at least qualify for the bronze meet.
 - O Dates for the Medal Meets are:
 - Bronze July 23
 - Silver July 26
 - Gold July 27
- Practices. Please view the schedule at the end. Practices are held after school from Tuesday, May 27 through Thursday, June 12. Morning practices go from June 16 through July 25.
- End of Season Party will be held on Sunday, July 27. Mark your calendars!
- Swimming Requirements. Swimmers must be able to swim the length of the pool; this is a friendly-competitive team NOT swim lessons (although your child's swimming stroke improvement is one of the goals of our coaches). If they cannot swim the length or your swimmer needs more help YOU HAVE TIME get them involved in lessons NOW (check out the YMCA and the Severna Park Community Center).

- Calling all High Schoolers! Do you have a high schooler who would be interested in swimming? We need more high schoolers to be able to compete against other teams (we can't get points for races if we don't have swimmers). High schoolers (ages 15 18) who are not members of the Ulmstead Swim Club can join the swim team at NO extra cost. They still have to pay the swim team registration fee. They can only use the pool for swim team purposes. Parents of these high schoolers are exempt from volunteering if desired.
- Parent Volunteers Make the Season Successful! It takes an Ulmstead village to make a swim team fun and successful for our kids! Our network of parents keeps the team organized and allows our meets to run smoothly. Each family is expected to fulfill their required volunteer assignments. You select your volunteer positions when you register for the swim meets you plan to attend it is first come, first pick. See the job descriptions on the website under PARENTS VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTIONS. The number of volunteer assignment requirements will depend on how many families register. More details to come.
- Stroke and Turn/Starter Update We encourage parents who want to try something different to give Stroke and Turn Judge or Starter a try! While a short training is required, these are rewarding roles, and you are on deck to see your kiddo swim. If you swam competitively as an adult in college, Masters Swimming or Ulmstead Triathlon, we need your help! Share your expertise with the Ducks this summer as a stroke and turn judge or starter.
