Recreation Center Project Update

The team continues to make progress and is gearing up for some important milestones.

We are now moving into Design Development phase of the project and are working with our architects and a cost estimator to make sure the design stays aligned with our budget. As we shared in the last Weathervane update, this is a key step to help both the full committee and the finance team plan as we move forward.

We are in the final stages of Civil planning and are developing our communications package to submit to the County. As we have stated, it is not the building that is complicated—it is the site itself. Our engineering teams and land use attorneys have been invaluable in helping us navigate this process. While it certainly feels long and arduous, this is unfortunately the nature of building in the challenging Critical Area in AA County.

Our goal is to present recommendations (designs, site plan, and budget) to the community prior to the budget meeting. While there will certainly be a top-line update at the budget meeting itself, we know many crave more detail than time will allow at the budget meeting on November 15.

The Barn


October 11 starting at 4:00 p.m.
